

Data Policy

Effective April 4, 2023

Rapideditor.org is a service designed to help the mapping community by using artificial intelligence and our map editing tools to enhance high-resolution satellite imagery. Rapideditor.org is available online under the website <https://rapideditor.org> (hereinafter referred to as the “**Website**”). This policy describes our practices for handling your information on the Website .

Collection of Information

When you interact with us through our Website, we may collect or receive the following types of information:

Information you provide directly to us. For certain activities, we may collect the following types of information:

- Contact information, such as name, login and email address; and
- Information you provide us when you send us correspondence, provide comments, subscribe to a service, or otherwise participate in the Website.

Information we collect automatically. We may also collect certain information automatically when you use our Website, such as your Internet protocol (IP) address, mobile device identifier, browser type, operating system, Internet service provider, pages that you visit before and after using the Website, the date and time of your visit, information about the links you click and pages you view within the Website, and other standard server log information.

Information we obtain from other sources. We may receive information about you from other sources, including through third-party services and organizations, which we may combine with other information we receive about you. In particular, in order to be able to contribute content to the world map, such as information regarding roads or buildings (among others), it is necessary that you first open an account with OpenStreetMap. The required registration process is described on the OpenStreetMap website. OpenStreetMap is a community-driven project to create a free and editable map of the world.

How We Use Information

We may use the information you provide us to:

- **Meet our legitimate interests**, including to fulfill your requests for resources, services, and information; analyze the use of the Website and user data to understand, improve and operate the Website; and customize the content you see when you use the Website;
- **Meet our legal obligations**, including to prevent potentially prohibited or illegal activities and otherwise in accordance with our Terms of Use and comply with legal requirements; and
- **For any other purposes** disclosed to you at the time we collect your information or pursuant to your consent.

How We Share Information

There are certain circumstances in which we may share your information with certain third parties without further notice to you, as set forth below:

- **Authorized third-party vendors and service providers.** We share your information with third-party vendors and service providers that help us with specialized services, including email deployment, business analytics, marketing, and data processing. These services providers are limited from using your information for any purpose other than to perform services for us.
- **Affiliates.** We may share your information with our affiliates, which are companies that control, are controlled by, or are under common control with Facebook.
- **Legal purposes.** We may disclose information to respond to subpoenas, court orders, legal process, law enforcement requests, legal claims or government inquiries, detect fraud, and to protect and

defend the rights, interests, safety, and security of Facebook, our affiliates, owner, users, or the public.

- **Business transfers.** We may share your information in connection with a substantial corporate transaction, such as the sale of a website, a merger, consolidation, asset sale, or in the unlikely event of bankruptcy.
- **With your consent.** We may share information for any other purposes disclosed to you at the time we collect the information or pursuant to your consent. If you choose to engage in public activities on the website, you should be aware that any information you share there can be read, collected, or used by other users of these areas. You should use caution in disclosing personal information while participating in these areas. We are not responsible for the information you choose to submit in these public areas.

Your Rights

In accordance with applicable laws, you may have the right to access, rectify, port and erase your information, as well as the right to restrict and object to certain processing of your information. How We Protect Information

Your California Privacy Rights

We do not share personal information with third parties for their own direct marketing purposes.

Do-Not-Track Signals and Similar Mechanisms

Some web browsers transmit “do-not-track” signals to websites. Because of differences in how web browsers incorporate and activate this feature, it is not always clear whether users intend for these signals to be transmitted, or whether they even are aware of them. We currently do not take action in response to these signals.

Children’s Information

We do not knowingly collect or store information from children under the age of 13, unless permitted by law. We will delete any information we may have inadvertently received from a child under 13 upon notice. If you have reason to believe that a child under the age of 13 has provided personal information to us through our Website, please contact us and we will endeavor to delete that information from our databases.
